
## Christmas Doman Cards

#### Santa Claus

  - They grow on a host tree or shrub.
  - European mistletoe has white berries.

- It is made with milk, cream, sugar and eggs.
- In Venezuela and Trinidad, they consume a version of eggnog called Ponche Crema.

- Candy cane is a candy that is eaten around the Christmas season
